



Axis Modern Slavery Statement

We are committed to improving our practices to combat slavery and human trafficking.

We are a provider of contract hire equipment for the logistics and supply chain management industries around the UK. We are the parent company of the Axis group which is comprised of Axis Fleet Management Limited and Axis Fleet Management Leasing Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'Group'). The Group has over 44 employees and operates in the UK only. The Group had an annual turnover of £38,430,000 as at the year end March 2017.

Our business is organised into 5 business units: Finance, Fleet Services, Operations, Sales & Marketing and Senior Management.

Our supply chains include: repair, maintenance and operational services, manufacturers of trucks, rigids and trailers, storage facility providers, financing services, breakdown services, software, hardware and tyre providers.

We are committed to ensuring that there is no modern slavery or human trafficking in our supply chains or in any part of our business. Our Modern Slavery Policy reflects our commitment to acting ethically and with integrity in all our business relationships and to implementing and enforcing effective systems and controls to ensure slavery and human trafficking is not taking place anywhere in our supply chains.

As part of our initiative to identify and mitigate risk we will put in place systems to:

- Identify and assess potential risk areas in our supply chains.
- Mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in our supply chains.
- Monitor potential risk areas in our supply chains.

We have zero tolerance to slavery and human trafficking. To ensure all those in our supply chain and contractors comply with our values we will introduce a supply chain compliance programme. This consists of requesting from all our suppliers' copies of their policies and statements which confirm and outline what actions they are taking to mitigate slavery and human trafficking.

We have a dedicated Corporate Lawyer who will provide training to our staff and ensure a high level of understanding of the risks of modern slavery and human trafficking in our supply chains and our business.

This statement is made pursuant to section 54(1) of the Modern Slavery Act 2015 and constitutes our Group's slavery and human trafficking statement for the financial year ending March 2017.
